

CIHR DOCTORAL RESEARCH AWARDS - DFSA/CGSD

The Canadian Institutes of Health Research (CIHR) Doctoral Research Awards Program funds applications in any area of health research. Two streams of scholarships are administered through a single application:

- Frederick Banting & Charles Best Canada Graduate Scholarships-Doctoral Awards (CGSD)
- Doctoral Foreign Study Awards (DFSA)

Students apply to the CIHR Doctoral Awards program and top-ranked applicants are awarded a CGSD or DFSA depending on the proposed location where the doctoral degree will be pursued and granted.

- \$30,000 per year plus a \$5000 research allowance per year

OGS AND QEII

GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIPS IN SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY

OGS awards are merit-based scholarships available to students in all disciplines of graduate study. The Queen Elizabeth II Graduate Scholarships in Science and Technology (QEII-GSST) program is in addition to and harmonized with the OGS program. QEII-GSST awards are merit-based scholarships available to domestic students in graduate study undertaking research in science and technology fields.

• \$15,000 for one year (three consecutive terms)

A student may select either a May 1, September 1 or January 1 start date provided they are registered full-time in the degree program at the award start date.

A student may accept the award for just two (2) terms, or \$10,000. Awards must be held for at least two consecutive full terms.

The Application is divided into five components and can be completed at your own pace:

- **January 31, 2017-** <u>complete</u> application, including letters of reference. All submissions made to Graduate Administrator.
